

### **Early Admissions Program Regulations**

for individuals who entered EAP in Fall 2004 as transfer/second-year students

Continuation in the EAP and admission to the professional program is being granted with the assumption that all pre-pharmacy courses will be successfully completed prior to fall 2006. The following criteria must be satisfied in order to continue in the EAP and begin the Pharm.D. program in fall 2006:

1. Be continuously enrolled at OSU for the 2004-2006 academic years
2. Maintain a cumulative GPA of at least 3.25 in university coursework
3. Earn a minimum GPA of 3.00 for each quarter
4. Adhere to the Student Life Policies and Regulations and the OSU Academic Regulations – see the OSU Schedule of Classes
5. Begin the Pharm.D. program no later than fall 2006.

As an EAP student, you must complete at least 36 credit hours for the academic year (excluding summer, AP and/or transfer credits) with a minimum cumulative OSU GPA of 3.25. Letter grades of U or I or N do not apply toward these GPA requirements, nor do “repeated” classes or withdrawals. Review of your cumulative GPA will be completed each year after spring term grades are posted for the first two years. Your cumulative GPA will also be checked at the end of the fall term of your third year (approximately one year before you begin the Pharm.D. program). Failure to achieve a quarter GPA of 3.00 or better in any two quarters or failure to maintain the cumulative GPA of 3.25 will result in removal from the EAP and cancellation of your admission to the Pharm.D. program for fall 2006. Students are also expected to maintain continuous enrollment at OSU.
