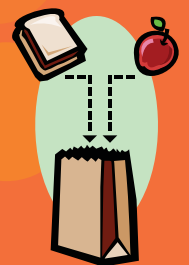

This year's Spring Outreach Project (March 29) will involve the following site activities:

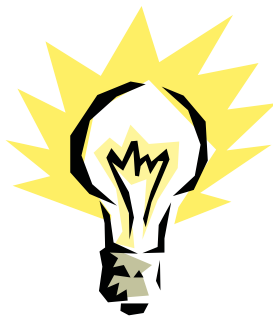
