TWO GRAD STUDENTS WIN FORUM

The 25th Annual Oregon Health and Science University Student Research Forum was held May 8th & 9th at OHSU. Two College of Pharmacy graduate students walked away from the event with top placements.

Anand Venkataraman, a student in Molecular and Cellular Biology (Dr. Mark Leid's lab), won the top prize for his podium presentation in the Aging section. This honor was accompanied by a \$300 cash prize. The title of Anand's presentation was "Understanding the role of GRASP in aged skin." The second student, Olga Golonzhka, a student in Biochemistry/Biophysics (Dr. Mark Leid's lab), won second prize for her podium presentation in the Epithelial Biology section. This honor was accompanied by a \$200 cash prize. The title of Olga's presentation was "Dual role of COUP-TF-interacting protein 2 (CTIP2) in regulating epidermal homeostasis and skin barrier formation during mouse fetal development."



Both of the projects represent collaborations between Dr. Mark Leid and Dr. Arup Indra's laboratories.
