Even with the stormy conditions, we still managed to perform 36 blood glucose screenings and at least a dozen people bared their arms in the cold to have a blood pressure check. A few individuals even stopped by to receive information from the smoking cessation and asthma awareness groups. Although we had less than 60 participants, the event was still a success because it proved our dedication and determination to serve the community.
